### Psychology supervisor list now available online

The Psychology Board of Australia (the Board) today announced the launch of the online supervisor list on its website.

The searchable list, which is accessible from the 'Supervision' page under the 'Registration' tab on the Board's website, publishes the name and principal place of practice of all Board-approved supervisors.

The supervisor list is separate to the [National Register of Practitioners](#) and can be used to search for information that is not held on the National Register, such as the types of supervision an approved supervisor can provide, and if consent has been given a contact email address.

The list will be particularly useful for fourth year psychology students and provisional psychologists seeking a supervisor for the 4+2 program, and final year Master and Doctorate students and general psychologists seeking a supervisor for the registrar program leading to area of practice endorsement.

The full list of Board approved supervisors includes psychologists who were approved as supervisors by a state or territory board prior to commencement of the National Scheme and were automatically recognised as approved supervisors by the National Board. It also includes psychologists who have applied to the National Board and been approved as a supervisor after 1 July 2010.
