Note. The majority of psychology supervisors are approved in more than one supervision category, therefore the figures in the table above include the same supervisors counted in multiple supervision categories. In total there are 5629 individual Board-approved supervisors.

In addition to the supervision categories shown in the table above, the Board approves supervisors for the 5+1 Internship (under development), for higher degree placements (Board approval required from 30 June 2013), and for working in addition to placements which has only recently been defined as a unique supervisor category. Statistics for these categories will be available in the future

^a PPP means Principal Place of Practice which is the address declared by the psychologist to be the address at which he or she is predominantly practising the profession. If the psychologist is not practising the profession or is not practising predominantly at one address the Principal Place of Practice may be the psychologist's principal place of residence.

^b An overseas Principal Place of Practice means that the address declared by the psychologist to be the address at which he or she is predominantly practising the profession is an address outside of Australia or the psychologist has not declared a Principal Place of Practice and their principal place of residence is not in Australia.
